#### **Facts & Comparisons legacy view retiring**

Facts & Comparisons, a solution of Wolters Kluwer Clinical Drug Information, recently introduced a new user interface for Facts & Comparisons eAnswers (online). As customers familiarized themselves with the redesigned Facts & Comparisons eAnswers navigation and content, they could continue to access the legacy Facts & Comparisons interface and toggle between the legacy and new interface views.

As of March 14, 2017, the toggle button to the legacy site has been removed, and the legacy site will be permanently retired after March 31, 2017.

#### **Lexicomp Online: Martindale comes to the TUC Library!**

As of March 16, 2017, TUC has access to Lexicomp's Martindale index.

Martindale is a respected international drug reference tool which provides a thorough review of pharmaceutical products available worldwide with a global focus on the identification of medications, local equivalents, manufacturers, and more. Martindale is available within the Lexicomp Online interface.

*Clinical Manual of Addiction Psychopharmacology* is a comprehensive guide to the pharmacology of drugs of abuse and the medications used to treat dependence on those substances. The second edition provides a thorough update on a broad range of addictive substances, along with enhanced coverage in areas where significant advances have been made since publication of the first edition.

Clinicians, including psychiatrists, psychiatric residents and fellows, and other mental health practitioners who encounter individuals with substance-related disorders in the course of their clinical work, will find the manual to be well-organized, exhaustively referenced, and current.
