❖ **Updates from the American Academy of Pediatrics Red Book:**

The newly revised and updated ***Red Book: 2018–2021 Report of the Committee on Infectious Diseases***, 31st Edition is now available on Red Book Online, the go-to resource for the most current information on infectious diseases. To view the new edition of ***Red Book 2018***, click the "Table of Contents" button on the home page of Red Book Online. Refer to the "Summary of Major Changes" to quickly see all the new and updated content in ***Red Book 2018***.

The American Academy of Pediatrics is planning to launch an "Outbreak" section on Red Book Online this summer that will focus on domestic infectious disease outbreaks, with weekly or monthly updates depending on severity or changes. Severe outbreaks of international infectious disease outbreaks will also be added.

The 2018 Immunization Schedules are available in Red Book Online, and corrections and updates to Red Book eBook will be inserted directly within the eBook on Red Book Online. The new text will be a different color and you'll see the option to view the original text.

In Pediatric Patient Education, the top 150+ handouts are now ICD-10-CM and CPT coded. Additional handouts will be coded throughout 2018.

New webinars have been posted on Pediatric Care Online. Upcoming webinars are likely going to be: Food Guidelines; Home Visiting; Nephrology (topic TBD). There are new videos in the editing stage that will be posted over the summer to Pediatric Care Online. These include:

#### ❖ Cancellations

As of June 30<sup>th</sup>, TUC will no longer subscribe to Boopsie, the TUC libraries' mobile application, or the NexisUNI law, business, and news database. The Touro System libraries have cancelled these consortium licenses due to low usage.

As of July 16<sup>th</sup>, the National Guideline Clearinghouse website will cease to exist due to discontinued federal funding of that department, and that resource will accordingly be removed from the TUC libraries' databases list.
