News of Note

- Many Library databases have recently or will soon transition to new (and improved!) interfaces. These include: eBrary, Science Direct, Journal of Clinical Psychiatry, ClinicalKey, and Pediatric Care Online.
- The Cochrane Library Databases have a new interface through Wiley. They also expanded their databases to include an additional two new databases, and a free mobile app for iPads.
- The Library has a new, permanent exhibit, “Mare Island Navy Yard: the Story of the First Pacific Coast U.S. Naval Base Told through Survey Maps” which is located on the wall between the north and south side of the Library (to the left of Library Room 217). This exhibit offers a unique and fascinating look at Mare Island’s history and was curated by Dr. Nikki Gothelf, who is currently working at TUC Library as a part-time librarian.
- The Library also has a new panorama photograph “Mare Island Strait 2013” by local photographer, Armando Picciotto.

Come see both the exhibit and photograph. Both are located in the hallway area between the north and south side of the Library.
